### Death Certificates

Certified copies for deaths in the state of Florida from 2009 to present are public record. Only immediate family may obtain the cause of death certificate. A valid photo ID is required.

*\$10 per copy*

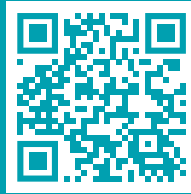

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## PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

### Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Services 904-272-3177

Nutrition education, counseling, and breastfeeding support. Provides supplemental foods for pregnant and breastfeeding women and children as well as infant formula and baby food.

### Tuberculosis (TB) Program 904-529-2800

Testing, diagnostic evaluations and treatment.

### Emergency Preparedness

Coordinates and staffs special needs shelter for Clay County citizens who need more care and supervision than a typical shelter.

### Community Health Education 904-529-2800

Promotes and coordinates community engagement and partnerships to offer chronic disease prevention education and screenings, hosts health events, and assesses community specific health needs.

### Disease Prevention and Control 904-529-2800 opt 6

Investigates, conducts surveillance, and provides guidance to control and prevent diseases.

#### Ryan White Program

Provides medical care, eligibility and case management services for people living with HIV.

#### AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)

Provides access to medications for eligible uninsured clients or by purchase of health insurance that includes coverage for HIV medications.

#### Services Include:

- Regulation of public water systems (non-SDWA).
- Investigates public and private drinking water complaints.
- Inspection of public swimming pools.
- Inspection of mobile home, RV parks and recreational camps.
- Inspection and regulation of septic tank systems.
- Inspection of group care facilities.
- Regulation of tattoo, body piercing and tanning facilities.
- Investigation of food and waterborne illnesses.
- Regulation of biomedical waste/SHARPS Disposal Program.

#### Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program

Pap smears and referrals for mammograms available.

#### School and Sport's Physicals

Physical examinations to meet the requirements of children enrolling in school or participating in school sports.

#### Family Planning Program

Counseling and family planning services, including pregnancy testing.

#### Refugee Health Program

STI and HIV testing and treatment.

#### Insulin and Epilepsy Medication

Required child and adult immunizations, including completed Immunization Form 680. Children's immunizations are available at no cost.
